Understanding Your Member Class

Selecting Your Member Class:

PENNBC offers four different member classes to accommodate everyone's employment situation: Active, Associate, Corporate, & Student Members.

Active – Any person whose primary duties involve administration, formulation or enforcement of laws, regulations or ordinances relating to public health, safety and welfare for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or a political subdivision thereof, including joint and multi-municipal agencies. Examples of these primary duties include, but are not limited to the PA Uniform Construction Code, Zoning Codes, Property Maintenance and Housing Codes, and Fire Codes. Active members may vote, hold office and chair standing committees, in addition to participation rights afforded to other classes of membership.

Associate – An associate member is an individual who does not meet the requirements of an Active member. Associate members have no voting privileges.

Student – If you attend school, at any level, studying building trades, design, construction or fabrication, you qualify for student membership.

Corporate – The corporate member category is for commercial (for-profit) entities with an interest, indeed a commitment, to the issues of importance to the code community. Individuals and municipalities cannot be corporate members. Those concerned with the

code adoption process, the products which code officials encounter in their day-to-day “enforcement” activities, and the products employed in the tasks of code enforcement would also find this classification of interest. Corporate members may designate up to three individuals to serve on committees, participate in discussions and attend PENNBC events at the event's member rate. Corporate members have no voting privileges. Representatives are named when dues are paid and may be changed once during the dues year.

Quantity Discounts:

An employer's first five “Active Members” are billed at the standard \$90 per person rate. The sixth and beyond “Active Members” receive a discount of \$30 per person.

Employers who are eligible for the Quantity Discount have the ability to change the employees assigned to the memberships they paid for. So, if you experience turn-over within your office, you can re-assign your paid membership from the outgoing staff member to the incoming employee without the need to pay a whole new membership fee (there is a \$10 administrative fee per change request).

PENNBC Regions

PENNBC is divided into four geographic regions. When you join PENNBC, you are automatically assigned to a local region.

Region 5 has added an additional mandatory \$20 per person local dues to fund its otherwise free local training events for members.

Accessing PENNBC's Website

Many of PENNBC's resources and registration discounts are tied to your PENNBC membership. To gain access to these benefits, you will first need to log in to your membership account.

Your PENNBC username can be either your account email address or full name (note: your first name and last name separated by a period without any other punctuation -- i.e., [Firstname].[Lastname]).

If you don't have your password, you can reset it by clicking on the “Lost Password” link on the login page. The website will send a reset link to your account email address so that you can set up a new password.

You can renew your membership online by first logging into your account and following the directions on the Join/Renew Page.
